WHO IS THE COURSE FOR:

Forest School practitioners (leaders & assistants) wanting to practice and apply their tools and craft skills & understanding.

Suitable for: Forest School Practitioners (Leaders & Assistants).

WHAT WILL THE WORKSHOP COVER:

This half-day woodland workshop will explore ways to apply tool techniques to make a range of musical instruments, including: tapping sticks, rattles, kazoos and whistles. The day is designed to provide continued professional development for Forest School leaders and assistants.

The workshop will include:

- ♪ Practical, hands on application of skills to make items using natural materials
- ♪ A reminder of tool safety and techniques
- ♪ A chance to practice your skills
- ♪ Exploration of how these skills could be undertaken by learners at Forest School
- ♪ Opportunities to develop your understanding about the properties of materials and finishing techniques.
- ♪ A flurry of musical activities

We will be spending the afternoon in our new woodland camp area. Please be aware that we have no indoor space so will be outside the whole time. Please ensure you bring appropriate outdoor clothing to be comfortable. We have a woodland shelter to use in wet weather and the campfire is always burning!
